



Open Water Diver

This two-weekend class teaches you the fundamentals of scuba diving to a depth of 60 feet. The class includes certification card, regulator, BC, tanks, wetsuit, and weights.

This class will cover the material in the book with a review, four short quizzes and one comprehensive test. Sunday the class meets at the base pool for confined water dives. Skills start with mask clearing, regulator recovery, alternate air source breathing and others. Then class will meet for open water dives, one and two. The last two dives will be completed at the Destin East Pass Jetties, a favorite local dive spot or the fresh water springs in Ponce De Leon.

(Ages 12 and up with a medical form)

Students Provide:

- Snorkeling Equipment (mask, fins, snorkel, booties and gloves)
- PADI Open Water Manual and Dive Table
- Entrance Fee to Springs (seasonal)

Advanced Open Water

This One-weekend class is strongly suggested to build confidence and fine tune skills. The areas cover deep diving procedures, navigation, boat diving, intro to wreck, and other dives to make you a more confident and better diver. There are a total of five dives.

Students Provide:

- Snorkeling Equipment (mask, fins, snorkel, booties and gloves)
- Underwater Reel and Compass
- PADI Advanced Open Water Manual
- Log Book

Rescue Diver

The rescue class is recommended for any diver who is looking for a leadership role in the diving community. The class teaches diver first aid, panicked diver and other techniques.

Students Provide:

- All appropriate SCUBA equipment
- PADI Rescue Diver Manual
- Log Book
- First Aid Kit

Dive Master (DM)

The PADI Divemaster Course is designed to train qualified individuals as supervisory personnel, and as such is the first level of diving as a professional. In this role, the Divemaster may oversee general diving activities and serve as an instructional assistant. Divemasters may also lead dives for certified divers.

Students Provide:

- All Appropriate SCUBA Equipment
- PADI Divemaster Manual
- Encyclopedia of Recreational Diving
- Diving Knowledge Workbook
- Log Book
- First Aid Kit and Emergency Signal

Prerequisites:

- PADI Rescue Diver Certification (or equivalent)
- Current CPR and First Aid Certification
- Be at Least 18 Years of Age
- Diving Medical Examination
- At Least 20 Logged Dives
